



# 2021-22 Goals and Objectives

## GOAL - Maintain Financial Sustainability

### *Objectives:*

1. Maintain a comparative tax rate position in relation to other Southeast Michigan communities by adjusting the General Fund, Solid Waste and Streets millage (s )
2. Have unappropriated reserve fund of 15% to 20% of annual expenses—[End of Year!](#)
  - Maintain an unrestricted general fund balance of 15% minimum to 20% maximum of expenditures
  - Maintain a capital outlay reserve in the enterprise funds of 50% to 75% of expenditures as recommended in the Utility Rate Study
3. Attract and maintain prudent growth through an ongoing commitment to economic development
  - Review existing incentives - IFT, REU assistance, etc -and/or create incentives for the types of development desired. . ✓

## GOAL - Ensure Good Stewardship of Municipal Infrastructure

### *Objectives:*

1. Establish policy for utilities management based on the following factors:
  - Water, Sewer, and Electrical rate review ✓
  - Sustainability Commission Recommendations—Community Solar—Final Report to be presented to Council by January 2021. ✓
  - Continue to budget for preventative maintenance for streets (crackfill, sealcoat, etc.) . ✓
  - Continue conversion to LED streetlights . ✓
  - Pursue joint meetings with **Sylvan and** Lima Township to establish regional solutions for utilities ✓
2. Complete the following project (s):
  - Sibley Re-surfacing— Plans submitted to State/Spring—Summer 2021 Construction . ✓
  - Lane, Arthur, Wellington and Dale Street, Curb, Sidewalks and Utilities—75% done and will be completed by end of November 2020. . ✓
  - Expand Tactical Urbanism project –Chelsea POP ✓
  - Sylvan Water system interconnect—Preliminary Engineering and Staff level Discussions with Sylvan Township ✓
3. Adjust the 5-year rolling Continuous Improvement Plan (CIP) for streets, including water, sewer and storm sewer infrastructure based on budget forecast. ✓
4. Adjust the 5-year rolling CIP for vehicles, equipment, buildings & systems based on budget forecast ✓
